1 - CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

"El Argentino 2013" – 1st International Salon of Photographic Art of Nuevo Foto Club Argentino is open to all Photographers around the world, amateurs and professionals. However an entry may be rejected when the sponsoring organization or its agent, in its reasonable discretion, believes the entry does not conform to exhibition rules and conditions. Submission of entries implies the acceptance of all conditions. The entrant must be the owner of all rights of the submitted works. All parts of the picture must be photographed by the author.

The contest is open for all pictures, digitally modified or not. The author agrees that his works may be published on a Printed catalog, on a CD catalog and on Internet WEB page free of charge. The works will not be used in a commercial context. There is no possibility of recourse to legal action.

The subject is free.

Monochrome Photography Definition

A black and white work fitting from the very dark grey (black) to the very clear grey (white) is a monochrome work with the various shades of grey. A black and white work toned entirely in a single color will remain a monochrome work able to stand in the black and white category; such a work can be reproduced in black and white in the catalogue of a salon under FIAP Patronage.

On the other hand a black and white work modified by a partial toning or by the addition of one color be-



comes a color work (polychrome) to stand in the color category; such a work requires color reproduction in the catalogue of a salon under FIAP Patronage.

Photo Travel Photography Definition (Color and/or Monochrome)

A Photo Travel image must express the feeling of a time and place, and portray a land, its distinctive features or culture in its natural state. There are no geographical limitations.

The extreme close-wasting identification, study models, or photographic manipulations that misrepresent reality or alter the content of the image are unacceptable in this section. Not allowed to move, clone, add, delete, rearrange or combine elements. The manipulations or modifications are not allowed, except for changes in size, cut, toned, and the recovery of the original color of the scene. Special effects filters are not allow. Derivations, including infrared, are unacceptable. All adjustments must appear natural. Conversion to full monochrome is acceptable. Derivations, including infrared, are unacceptable.

4 - ENTRY FORM AND SENDING PICTURES:

A maximum of 4 photographs (4 files) for each section (12 photographs maximum) can be submitted, after registering personal information with the online entry form (www.nuevofca.com.ar/el-argentino).

A list of all the files received will be published in our web page, for control purposes, with the notification of the entry fee received and conditions of opening files. The list will be kept updated.

5 - DIMENSIONS OF PHOTOS (SIZE):

Photographs must be saved in JPG format, in 300 dpi resolution and not exceed 2 MB. Maximum image size is 1440 pixels (wide) x 1080 pixels (high).

6 - DISPLAY RESOLUTION:

Photographs will be judge with a high definition monitor.

7 - IDENTIFICATION:

It is not necessary to encode the file. The file name can have a maximum length of 20 characters, special characters cannot be used. Use only English letters (a-z)

Regarding the title of the photographs there are no restrictions on the use of special characters and can have an extension of up to 30 characters.

8 - ENTRY FEE:

Entry fee is:

- » USD 20: 1 (one) section
- » USD 25: 2 (two) sections
- » USD 30: 3 (three) sections

The Argentine authors pay a single amount of \$ 50 to participate in the 3 sections.

For Latin American authors the value will be USD 15 for the 3 sections.

A 10% discounts will be granted for group entries (more than 10 authors), consult at el-argentino@nuevof-ca.com.ar (not valid for Argentinean or Latin American countries)

Payment must be made before the closing date (Sunday September the 15th, 2013)



The Works of the authors who do not pay entry fee will not be taken into consideration.

9 - JURY:

The judging will take place on September the 28th, 2013. A total scoring per author will be established according to the total amount of the points of the accepted works among the maximum 12 submitted works of the three sections (4 per section) by the same author.
