

FEDERACION ARGENTINA DE FOTOGRAFIA INTERNATIONAL EXHIBITION 2014

1 - CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

-The FAF International Salon is open to all Photographers around the world, amateurs and professionals. However an entry may be rejected when the sponsoring organization or its agent, in its reasonable discretion, believes the entry does not conform to exhibition rules and conditions. Submission of entries implies the acceptance of all conditions. The entrant must be the owner of all rights of the submitted works. All parts of the picture must be photographed by the author. The contest is open for all pictures, digitally modified or not.

The author agrees that his works may be published on a Printed catalog, on a CD catalog and on Internet WEB page free of charge. The works will not be used in a commercial context. There is no possibility of recourse to legal action.

- Entries must originate as photographs (image-capture of objects via light sensitivity) made by the entrant on photographic emulsion or acquired digitally. By virtue of submitting an entry, the entrant certifies the work as his/her own and permits the sponsors to reproduce all or part of the entered material free of charge for publication and / or display in media related to the exhibition. This may include low resolution posting on a website. The exhibition assumes no liability for any misuse of copyright. Images may be altered, either electronically or otherwise, by the maker and artwork or computer graphics created by the entrant may be incorporated if the photographic content predominates.

The subject is free.

Photo Travel Photography Definition (FIAP) (color and monochrome)

A Photo Travel image must express the feeling of a time and place, and portray a land, its people, or a culture in its natural state. Photo Travel images have no geographical limitations. Ultra close-ups which lose their identity and studio-type model shots are unacceptable.

Techniques that add to, relocate, replace or remove any element of the original image, except by cropping, are not permitted. Techniques that enhance the presentation of the image, without changing the photo travel content, are permitted. All adjustments must appear natural.

Photo Travel Photography Definition (PSA) (color and monochrome)

A Photo Travel image must express the feeling of a time and place, and portray a land, its distinctive features or culture in its natural state. There are no geographical limitations. Close-up

pictures of people or objects must include distinguishable environment. Techniques that add to, relocate, replace or remove any element of the original image, except by cropping, are not permitted. All adjustments must appear natural. Conversion to full monochrome is acceptable. Derivations, including infrared, are unacceptable.

Monochrome Photography Definition (FIAP)

A black and white work fitting from the very dark grey (black) to the very clear grey (white) is a monochrome work with the various shades of grey.

A black and white work toned entirely in a single colour will remain a monochrome work able to stand in the black and white category; such a work can be reproduced inblack and white in the catalogue of a salon under FIAP Patronage.

On the other hand a black and white work modified by a partial toning or by the addition of one colour becomes a colour work (polychrome) to stand in the colour category; such a work requires colour reproduction in the catalogue of a salon under

FIAP Patronage.

Monochrome Photography Definition (PSA)

Monochrome image is defined as having varying shades of no more than one color (various shades of that color from very light to very dark) but it may be any single color. Multi-toned images (various shades of two or more colors) and greyscale images with added an accent color are not acceptable in Monochrome Class sections and must be entered in Color Class sections

Nature Definition (FIAP)

Nature photography depicts living, untamed animals and uncultivated plants in a natural habitat, geology and the wide diversity of

natural phenomena, from insects to icebergs.

Photographs of animals which are domesticated, caged or under any form of restraint, as well as photographs of cultivated plants

are ineligible. Minimal evidence of humans Is acceptable for nature subjects, such as barn owls or storks adapting to an environment modified by humans, or natural forces, like hurricanes or tidal waves, reclaiming it. The original image must have been taken by the photographer, whatever photographic medium is used. Any manipulation or modification to the original image is limited to minor retouching of blemishes and must not alter the content of the original scene. After satisfying the above requirements, every effort should be made to use the highest level of artistic skill in all nature photographs.

Nature Definition (PSA)

Nature photography is restricted to the use of the photographic process to depict observations from all branches of natural history, except anthropology and archeology, in such a fashion that a well-informed person will be able to identify the subject material and to certify as to its honest presentation. The **story telling** value of a photograph **must** be weighed more than the pictorial quality while maintaining high technical quality. Human elements shall not be present, except where those human elements enhance the nature story. The presence of scientific bands, scientific tags or radio collars on wild animals is permissible. Photographs of artificially produced hybrid plants or animals, mounted specimens, or obviously set arrangements, are ineligible, as is any form of manipulation that alters the truth of the photographic statement. **No** techniques that add to, relocate, replace, or remove pictorial elements except by cropping are permitted. Techniques that enhance the presentation of the photograph without changing the nature story or the pictorial content are permitted. All adjustments must appear natural. Color images can be converted to grayscale monochrome. Infrared images are not allowed.

4 - SENDING PICTURES:

A máximum of 4 pictures (4 files) for each section (16 images max) can be sent, with the personal information to the online entry form (www.faf-internacional.com).

A list of all the files we received will be published on the Internet Web Page, for controlling purposes, with the notification of entry fee received and conditions of opening files. The list will be kept updated.

5 – PHOTO DIMENSION (SIZE):

The images must be saved in JPG format, in 72dpi resolution and not exceed 2 MB. Maximum image size is 1440 pixels (wide) x 1050 pixels (high)

6 - DISPLAY RESOLUTION:

Monitor connected with multimedia projector will be also set at 1440 x 1050 with 16.7 millions colors, LAN (Local Area Network) connected with the Judging Assistant PC.

7 - IDENTIFICATION:

The file name should not contain more than 20 characters. There are no restrictions on the name (title) of the photo.

8 - ENTRY FEE:

The Works of the authors who do not pay participation fee will not be taken into consideration.

9 - JURY

The judging will take place on December 19 and 20, 2014.

An entrant's four images will be distributed throughout four rounds of judging The decision of the Panel of selectors is final and binding, no further appeal will be accepted

A total scoring per author will be established according to the total amount of the points of the accepted works among the maximum 16 submitted works of the four sections (4 per section) by the same author. This will be used for the awards per author
